Subject: Used PCs etc. for aid projects

Dear Sir/Madam,

Companies and individuals give us used PCs, laptops, monitors and accessories, which we refurbish and then distribute free of charge to people who cannot afford such devices but urgently need them. We must have handled over a thousand.

Due to the COVID-19 crisis, there is currently a very high demand. The need is so great that we currently can only give devices to people with school-age children.

In addition to many inquiries from private individuals and smaller NGOs, we currently have inquiries from organizations and groupings like

- - women's shelters

where it is always a question of several devices for students or trainees.

In addition to donations from individuals, we also have received devices from

and I can assure you that the cooperation was always problem-free and to the satisfaction of the supporting entities.

We are pleased to issue confirmation of the deletion of any existing data or destruction of the data carriers and we will work together with your IT department.

Deletion of the data carrier either with *parted magic* or *blancco* from www.dban.org, if required, with a signed deletion protocol.

Of course, we are happy to share your support with the public as far as we can.

Although the association has only been around since May, we have already been interviewed on the radio, Radio Wien, Hadschi Bankhofer, and in several small newspaper reports.
